Keeping Safe, In and Out of Shul



In an effort to make sure that everyone stays safe in Shul, we are implementing the following procedures:

At all times there will be a phone on in the Shul to receive advance warnings.

Upon receiving an advance warning (usually 5 to 8 minutes before a siren) every member should leave the sanctuary.

- All shul members with limited mobility should proceed to the shul's Mamad (safe room) and wait for an all-clear message.
- Members who live within a 5 minute walk should go home and wait for an all clear message on the phone in their Mamad.
- Members who live farther than a 5 minute walk should take a Mamad card directing them to a Mamad in the neighborhood and proceed to that address. Mamad Cards will be found in a box on the top of the magazine rack in the Shul Lobby.

Members should return only after hearing the all-clear message.

Please note that these rules apply at any point in Tefillah, including the middle of the Shmoneh Esrai.

THIS shabbat

IS GOING TO BE huge!

Q. Why is this Shabbat called Shabbat Hagadol?

A. There are many answers offered in various Seforim. (See Dirshu 530: 1). The Chizkuni writes that something extraordinary happened on the last Shabbat before the exodus from Egypt. On that fateful day, our forefathers performed the first-ever national Mitzvah, which was *Lekichat Haseh* — taking the sheep and preparing the Korban Pesach. They all set their designated animals aside on the tenth day of Nissan, which fell on Shabbat that year, and —

with that great act of faith — started something *GADOL*, namely Shemirat Hamitzvot! That is the reason for Shabbat *HAGADOL*!

With God's help, we will take this tradition to new heights this year, with the first national Korban Pesach in 2,000 years, turning this Pesach into *PESACH HAGADOL*!

Right Around the Corner!

The **Sar Shalom of Belz**, zt"l, notes that the Pasuk quoted of ¹על מצות ומררים יאכלהו — that the Korban Pesach must be eaten with Matzot and Maror, is actually a Pasuk written in connection with the Mitzvah of Pesach Sheni, the "makeupday" if one missed bringing the Korban Pesach.

He asks: Why didn't the Hagaddah quote the primary source — the Pasuk of the actual Korban Pesach, where it also mentions the requirement to bring it with Matzah and Maror?

Reb Yehoshua, zt"l, the son of the Sar Shalom answered that at our Seder, we see that we do not have the actual Korban Pesach yet, but we are optimistic that the rebuilding of the Bait Hamikdash will take place very soon, and we will be able

to bring the Pesach Sheini *this year*.

Therefore, we deliberately quote a Pasuk referring to Pesach Sheini, to reaffirm our belief that Mashiach is around the corner and that the rebuilding of the Temple will be in time for us to bring the Pesach Sheni This year!²
