WHERE TO hangout

Q. Which doorways of one's home are Biblically obligated in the Mitzvah of Mezuzah?

A. While some people think that only the front door has a Biblical Mitzvah, the Halacha is that every doorway of one's home which meets the following five conditions is obligated:

1. The room is at least 4 x 4 Amot (approximately 6 x 6 feet).
2. There is a door by the doorway.
3. The room is a Mechubad (respectable) room, as opposed to

a bathroom.

4. There are two door posts.
5. There is a proper lintel above the doorway.

Even without fulfilling all of these conditions, it may still require a Mezuzah on a Rabbinic level. Consult your Rav for the specifics of your case.

יחר למשה מאד ויאמר אל ה' אל תפן אל מנחתם לא חמור אחד מהם נשאתי ולא הרעתי את אחד מהם (במדבר טו:טו) **Hear. Absorb. React.**

Datan and Aviram had been a thorn in Moshe Rabeinu's side from the moment that Moshe burst onto the scene as a young prince in Egypt. On the first day that Moshe leaves the palace confines, he sees an Egyptian hitting a Jew, and he kills the Egyptian and buries him in the sand.

The next day, he once again leaves the palace and is greeted by the spectacle of a Jew hitting a fellow Jew! When he approaches them, they say, 'are you going to kill us as you killed the Egyptian?' Moshe knew that he was not safe, as Lashon Harah had been spoken about him, and it would only be a matter of time until Pharaoh arrested him!

Who were these two Jews? Chazal tell us that they were none other than Datan and Aviram

From day one, they were trouble for Moshe Rabeinu!

Rav Yerucham of Mir notes that we see how a person must judge and weigh all their actions.

When Datan and Aviram accused Moshe Rabeinu of seeking to dominate the people, Moshe could have dismissed their claim as that of two evil, foolish men who had an axe to grind with him. After all, there was bad history between them! So why pay attention to their ludicrous charges against him?

Instead, Moshe listened to their charges, retraced his steps and his actions, immersed himself in introspection, and then declared לא חמור אחד מהם נשאתי ולא הרעתי את אחד מהם – you are wrong! I have never done anything to harm you and am undeserving of these charges.

We often dismiss things said against us as the unfair rantings of people with a negative bias towards us, and our immediate conclusion is that we are right and they are wrong.

Moshe Rabeinu teaches us that even when accused of something by enemies and wicked people, we must examine our actions to ascertain and be sure that there is nothing in their claims. Only then can we declare: I am right, and you are wrong!¹

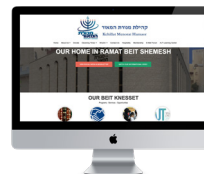
