Q: Should one who hurts his/her fellow Jew ask for Mechila (forgiveness) right away, or can one wait until Erev Yom Kippur?

A: According to the Halacha, the Mitzvah of Teshuva applies immediately. Therefore, one must make amends as soon as possible. Of course, at times the feelings of pain and anger may be so strong that a "cooling down" period may be necessary before Shalom can be

reestablished. If one neglected the Mitzvah until Yom Kippur, then there is now an additional reason to ask for Mechila, and that is Yom Kippur Kapara, which is only achieved when one takes care of *all* matters, both between man and God, as well as between man and his/her fellow man.

May God bless us all with a productive Teshuva season!



צדק צדק תרדוף

(דברים טז:כ)

Justice, Not Justification

The command to pursue righteousness is stated in the parshah, and the Torah uses the double expression of צדק צדק תרדוף—Justice, justice shal you pursue.

Rav Yaakov Globberman, shlit"a, explains that the pursuit of what is correct and honest needs to be constant throughout one's life. So often, we set ourselves noble and righteous aims and goals, but the road to achieving them is splattered with injustices, lies and deceit. We justify it by saying that the ends justify the means.

The use of the double expression emphasizes that:

צדק – you have to remain honest and correct...

צדק צדק תרדוף – as you pursue your noble goals and aims.¹
